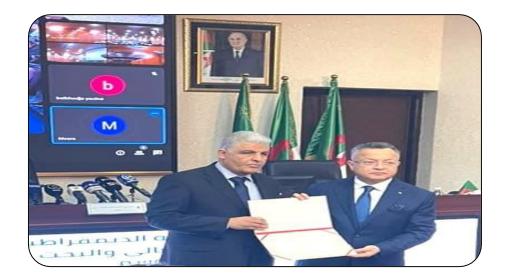
Transition to Fourth-Generation University
