Policy for the Conservation and Restoration of Terrestrial Ecosystems

Description:

The University of El Oued is committed to the conservation, restoration, and sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems, particularly forests, mountains, and drylands.

Scope:

4. Organize educational programs for students and the community on ecosystem restoration techniques.
